Description: Spread **kindness** and joy to your friends, family and neighbors in a fun, creative way – sidewalk chalk art!

Time to Complete: 15-30 minutes

Supplies Level: Light

Tags: K-2nd, 3rd – 5th, Kindness, Curiosity, Developing Character

Random Acts of Kindness (RAKs) are small gestures that inspire others to be kind, thus starting a ripple of kindness that can move throughout your neighborhood, town, city and the world! One fun, simple RAK is spreading joy, hope, and inspirational messages through chalk art.

Step 1: Get **curious** about chalk art and all the unique and creative ways we can use it to spread kindness. Do some research on blending chalk art, chalk art photos, and images of kindness chalk art messages.

Step 2: Brainstorm where you can create your chalk art to inspire kindness. A friend’s house? Grandparent’s house? At a neighbor’s? Your own sidewalk? Select your first chalk art location.

Step 3: Gather your supplies –

- Sidewalk chalk
- Imagination
- Other possible chalk art supplies – cup of water, paint brush

Step 4: Create your art and next to it write “Keep the ripple of kindness going – make chalk art for another!” Your chalk art can create a virtual ripple of kindness, too! Share a photo of your art on social media using #RAK and #LiveInsideOut.
